



Alcohol Policy

Liability and Responsibilities

Renting Party

The Alpine Art Center is renting the facility to you as a private party and is informing you of your sole liability and responsibility for you and your guests and the handling and purchase of the alcohol. An independent agreement should be made with the Licensed Bartender for their individual responsibilities and duties. The bartender is not under the employment of the Alpine Art Center.

Renting parties should furnish all alcohol, garnish, mixers, glasses, straws, napkins, etc. Arrangements can be made with your bartender for picking up and providing these items. We recommend wine and beer bars for simplicity and the reduction of your liability that may arise from stronger alcohol service bars. All Alpine Art Center catering rules, policies and costs apply.

Alcohol Service Charge

\$200

The service charge includes: a choice of 60" round or a 48" round table with ivory colored skirting and overlay, chilling of alcohol on day of event only, ice, water, and for the extra clean-up due to alcohol usage and service.

Requirements

A Licensed bartender is required to be on duty the entire time that alcohol is available. The certification of bartender must be provided and on file to the Alpine Art Center before service will be allowed. It is suggested that one server be required for every 100 guests being served. Our staff is not permitted to handle any alcohol nor touch and dispose of empty glasses. This remains the responsibility of the renting party.
